WHAT

Dates: June 28th–July 5th, 2026

WHERE

In Granada and through Andalusia, rediscovering cities such as Seville and the contrasts of the province of Malaga.

While most nights will be spent in Granada, the final two nights of the program will take place in Málaga to round out the experience.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

- Special orientation sessions.
- GRIIS **coordination and support** throughout the 7 days.
- Cultural program with **selected sessions, workshops, visits and activities.**
- **Transportation** organized for scheduled activities.
- **Tickets** and materials needed for the experiences included.
- **Selected meals** are included on key days of the itinerary.
- **Pre-trip assistance and logistical support:** accommodation recommendations, practical information.

Not included:

- International flights or airport transfers (we can help with arrangements upon request).
- Children's activities (we can make arrangements with summer camps so children can have their own experience while their parents participate in the program).

WHY

- Rediscover Andalusia through dialogue and selected experiences, viewed from an **adult and thoughtful perspective.**
- Relevant and **contemporary content.** We will address key issues of today.
- **Flexible format.** Activities in English; freedom to choose accommodation; possibility of traveling with a partner, family member or friends.
- **Small groups.** Limited places to ensure an intimate, high-quality experience.

HOW

- Themed workshops that include talks and hands-on experiences.
- Meetings with local artists, academics and activists.
- Walks and moments in nature to landscape first-hand.
- Open afternoons to socialize, debate and enjoy local cuisine.

ACCOMMODATION

Each participant chooses his/her preferred option. GRIIS can provide a list of quality recommendations:

- Downtown boutique hotels
- Family-friendly options (apartments).
- Student residence to stay with other program participants
- More exclusive accommodations upon request.

SOMETHING MORE

- Participants can take part as guest speakers or accredited speakers (with diploma) in our seminars and talks.
- There is the option of extending your stay and enrolling in a teaching course aimed at obtaining professional accreditation from the CLM.
- While the program is delivered in English, participants will have the option to join select activities in Spanish for a deeper cultural and linguistic immersion.
